1. Introduction

1.1 About the Norwegian Defence Logistics Organisation

The Norwegian Armed Forces consist of approximately 23 000 persons (officers, civilian staff and conscripted) in peace, and 83 000 at mobilising. The Norwegian Armed Forces is subcategorized into; Logistics, Force Production, and Operational Activities. Logistics is represented by the Norwegian Defence Logistics Organisation (“NDLO”). In turn, NDLO operates as a support to Force Production, and Operational Activities - which are collectively represented by the Army; Royal Norwegian Navy; Royal Norwegian Air Force (RNoAF); Home Guard; and the operational units of the Armed Forces.

For NDLO, the concept of logistics extends to the provisioning of services, parts, and supplies to support Force Production and Operational Activities in peacetime, crisis and war. NDLO has the responsibility for all material from procurement to disposal. This includes maintenance of different categories of material, planning and accomplishment of procurement, and supply (purchase, storage, distribution, and resupply). NDLO also delivers a wide spectre of services; ranging from transportation of personnel and goods via advanced data processing to technological advising.

1.2 The Request for Information

The purpose of this Request for Information (RFI) is to provide NDLO with a more in-depth knowledge of the market with respect to potential suppliers, technical information, availability and price. The gathered information may be used as a basis for a procurement process in order to establish a framework agreement. The submitted respond as such shall not be considered binding for either of the Parties.



2. Information regarding needs for EMAR-training or EASA-training

2.1 Current situation and need

The Norwegian Armed Forces is currently working on implementing the European Military Airworthiness Requirements (EMAR). In order to implement the EMAR it is necessary with external support covering technical training and courses for the Norwegian Armed Forces personnel.

This RFI covers the Armed Forces need for EMAR 66 approved basic technical training. The below described needs for EMAR 66 approved basic technical training are entered in a prioritised sequence based on the level of services that can be provided.

The EMAR 66 approved basic technical training shall preferably be conducted at Kjevik on military aircrafts and equipment, however training at other locations may be considered. The Norwegian Armed forces can provide facilities and practice materials. All personnel working on Kjevik must have security clearance Nato Secret.

NDLO therefore requests descriptions of possible solutions offered, including the level of necessary cooperation between NDLO/The Norwegian Armed Forces and the supplier, timeline, availability, prices etc.

- Other costs incurred (e.g. related to travel and accommodation for instructors, consultants etc.)
- Prices stated in local currency, e.g. Euro €, USD \$ or NOK will be accepted
- All prices shall be stated excl. VAT.

The pricing mechanism and the basis for the prices, such as payment, delivery terms etc., should be stated.

Please inform if any functional and commercial requirements or conditions has a considerable impact on costs/prices.
